Deaf-Blindess is not what you think it is
People who are deaf-blind are not necesarilly fully deaf and blind, but have both of these senses affected.

The most common causes
The most common causes of Deaf-Blindness are Hereditary Syndromes, Complications of prematurity, Prenatal and Postnatal complications.

It can also lead to other disabilities
$64 \%$ of deaf-blind children also have cognitive disabilities.
$58 \%$ have physical dissabilities.
$51 \%$ have complex healthcare needs.

Each deaf-blind child has different needs and requires a highly-individualized program that addresses his or her particular interests and unique ways of learning.
