## What is a Sensory Disability?

It generally refers to a disability related to hearing, vision, or both hearing and vision.

#### **Know the Numbers**

In 2018, 3.6% of americans reported a Hearing Disability and 2.3% a Visual Disability.

# Not all deaf-blind people are fully deaf or blind

This is a common misconception, different people with deaf-blindness have different communication needs.

#### The most common causes of blindness

The most common causes of blindness are age-related such as macular degeneration, cataract, diabetic retinopathy, and glaucoma.

## The most common causes of hearing loss

The most common causes of hearing loss are aging, noise exposure, head trauma, viruses or diseases, genetics and cytotoxicity.
